



**NOTICE TO VOTERS  
GENERAL ELECTION  
November 8, 2022**

**ABSENTEE VOTING IN THE AUDITOR'S OFFICE:**

Absentee ballots will be available on **October 19, 2022** at the Muscatine County Auditor's Office and may be voted in the office until 4:30 P.M. on Monday, November 7, 2022.

**VOTER REGISTRATION INFORMATION:**

You must be registered to vote to participate in the General Election. Registration may be done in the following ways.

1. You may register in person in the Auditor's office. The deadline is 5:00 PM, Monday October 24, 2022.
2. You may mail your registration to the Auditor's office. Voter registrations that are mailed must be received by, or have been postmarked by October 24, 2022.
3. Election Day Registration: You may register at your polling place on Election Day by presenting a current photo ID and proof of residency to the election officials. Contact the Auditor's office for a list of approved documents.

**ABSENTEE BALLOTS BY MAIL:**

Absentee Ballot request forms can be submitted to the Auditor's office starting August 30, 2022. Absentee ballot requests forms must be received by the Auditor's office no later than 5:00 P.M. on October 24, 2022.

A ballot may be mailed to you upon your request. Requests can be made in writing (you must include your name, ID #, address, date of birth, name and date of election and signature and date) on an official absentee ballot request form. Official forms may be obtained by contacting the Auditor's office or on our website at [www.muscatinecountyia.gov](http://www.muscatinecountyia.gov).

Absentee ballots must be returned to the Auditor's office no later than 8:00 P.M. on Tuesday, November 8, 2022. Postmark dates DO NOT count.

**EXTENDED OFFICE HOURS:** In addition to the normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, the Muscatine County Auditor's Office will have extended hours on the following days:

8:00 AM to 5:00 PM

**Friday, November 4**

8:00 AM to 5:00 PM

**Saturday, November 5**

9:00 AM to 5:00 PM

The decennial census and its corresponding redistricting process re-drew legislative boundaries resulting in changes in precincts and polling place changes for some residents within Muscatine County. The new precincts went into effect on January 15, 2022 and the first scheduled election using the new precincts was the Primary Election held on June 7, 2022. Boundaries are established for ten years. A mailing to active registrants who have a new precinct and polling location will be mailed on or after October 19, 2022.
